## NOTICE TO TIPPED EMPLOYEES

## **Federal Law States:**

- 1. You must <u>report ALL your tips</u> to your employer each payroll period not just 8%.
- 2. <u>Everyone who received tips must report tips</u>. This includes busboys, bartenders, hostesses, doormen, etc.
- 3. You cannot wait and report your tips at the end of the year unless your tips are less than \$20 in a month.
- 4. <u>If you have not reported</u> enough tips than you will have a SHORTFALL AMOUNT appear on your W-2 at the end of the year.
- 5. The SHORTFALL AMOUNT is used by the IRS and State to assess additional tax, interest and penalties.
- 6. Your only defense against an IRS assessment for shortfall tips is a daily diary showing the amount of each guest check and the tip.
